

What is MEDACTIONPLAN™ FOR MEDICATION RECONCILIATION?

MedActionPlan for Medication Reconciliation is a web-based service designed to help healthcare organizations customize, document and print patient medication regimens, and automatically reconcile medications throughout the continuum of care. MedActionPlan helps satisfy the Joint Commission's National Patient Safety Goals, and the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requirements.

Key features:

- ▶ Quickly record and reconcile a list of current and discontinued medications—including dose, frequency, and route of administration for each medication.
- ▶ Document medication changes, including the date and the reason for a change, and the ordering physician's name.
- ▶ Interface with other information systems through standard protocols like HL7, avoiding redundant data entry.
- ▶ Provide each patient with a current, reconciled list of medications, and export MyMedSchedule® directly to patients so they can self manage their own daily medication schedules.

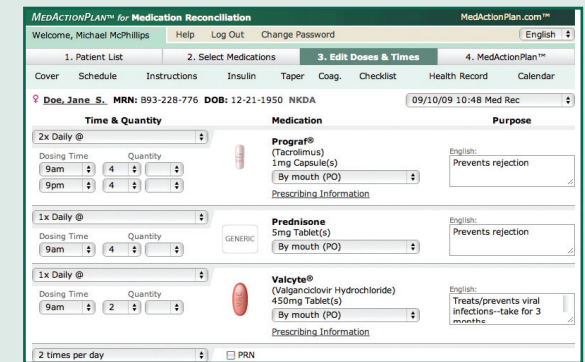
