**Special Instructions**—Dietary considerations for each medication. Instructions can be edited.

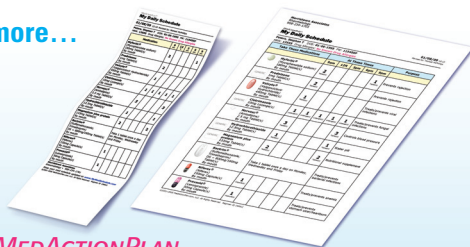
**Weekly Med Checklist**—Choose from weekly or monthly formats. Patients can keep track of what they take and when.

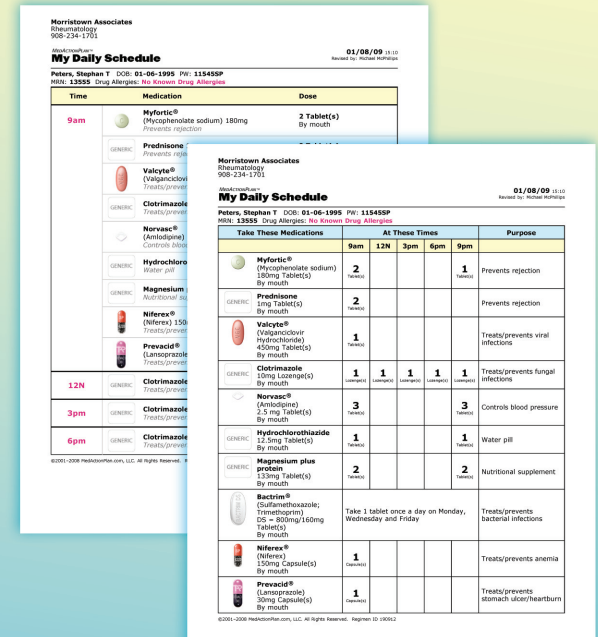

## Select Medications

Add medications with one of the following methods:

## Set Doses and Times

Multiple medication time slots can be set for each regimen:

- Select daily medication times—more than 6 time slots if needed
- Select quantity to be taken at each time
- Non-Daily option is used for medications with a special use application (e.g. "take one tablet every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday with breakfast")
